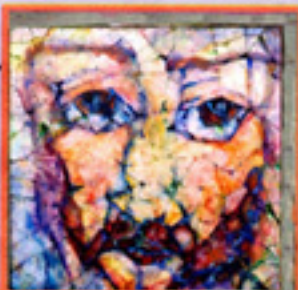

d. goth studied art privately and in colleges and universities throughout the California southland. She developed programs and taught art history technique and application in public and private schools. Along with her traditional canvas and paper paintings, she portrays her artistic talent on tile, stone and marble. She developed Hearts of Stone, a company that incorporates this technique, accompanied by her writings. It is marketed nationwide.

d. goth works in watercolor, pastel and acrylic on paper, canvas, stone and tile. Her work is primarily focused on portraying emotive subject matter, from hearts to human.

d. goth shows and sells her work nationwide and has received recognition and awards from galleries and juried competitions. In conjunction with her art work she is also a writer and poet. d. goth is a member of the artist guild of the San Diego Museum of Art, the San Diego Art Institute, the Offtrack Gallery in Leucadia, DEMA and the 101 Gallery in Encinitas.

"My paintings are composed in an assortment of mediums; watercolor, pastel and acrylic, portrayed on a variety of surfaces; paper, canvas, stone," d. goth explains. "Though the materials used are varied, all include the same type of subject matter, emotive. More often than not, those emotions are expressed in portrait style paintings of individuals engaged in intense situations or feelings. When I do paint other subject matter, I
